We need, Hare has!

This is the information that we need, from you as a hare, to help you have a successful trail, and for us to successfully find the beer. Suggested guidelines for items such as day, time, length, etc, are only suggestions. They are not law.

- Day / Date / Time:** Most importantly, we need to know when this hash is. We need to know to make ourselves available. This is generally the initial meeting time. Plan on starting the run between 20 to 30 minutes after the posted time.
- During the summer months, we usually set trail on Thursdays, with a 6PM posted time. With the nice weather, many locals travel in the summer. 6PM is usually enough time for people to get there after work, and for us to finish the run before dark.
- During the winter months, we generally set trail on Sundays, with a 2PM posted time. Week day hashes are not a good option due to an early dusk. (It gets dark early.)
- Location:** The second most important thing we need to know is where to go. We can't find the beer if we don't know where to start looking. Exact addresses are best, but intersections and business names work well, also.
- If this is an A to B hash (ends in a location other than where we started) we need to know that as well. Please have a plan for the pack to return to the beginning to retrieve their modes of transportation.
- On-In / On-After:** This is where an unorganized group of half minds may, or may not, end up after the closing ceremonies. This can be the location of the ceremonies, but does not have to be.
- Shiggy:** What is the shiggy forecast for this run? The level of shiggy may change the attire we wear for the run, or any chemical protections we may choose to bring with us.
- Pet friendliness:** Some hashers like to bring their pets with them, when possible. Please let us know if the trail, and On-In, are going to be pet friendly. If they are not, we will not bring them.
- Hash Cash:** Simply, we need to know how many dollars to give you for giving us beer.
- Notes:** Any other pertinent information we may need to know, that you feel like giving us, etc. This is also a good place for special instructions.
